RESOLUTION NO. 4793

A resolution authorizing the Administration to begin the restoration of the two historical cypress luggers, the Denver and Champion.

WHEREAS, on August 17, 1998, the members of the St. Charles Parish Council adopted Resolution No. 4553 authorizing the Administration to acquire three historical cypress luggers; and,

WHEREAS, on June 28, 1999, the Parish of St. Charles accepted a donation of two cypress luggers from the Victor Matherne family of Des Allemands; and,

WHEREAS, both the "Denver" and the "Champion" are historical artifacts worthy of preserving.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL do hereby authorize the Administration to begin the restoration of the two historical cypress luggers, the Denver and Champion with expenditures not to exceed \$45,000 for Phase I - Hull Repairs.
