- WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish submitted a Fiscal Year 2011 Community Challenge Planning Grant application for the LA 52 (Paul Maillard Road) Corridor Revitalization Plan; and,
- WHEREAS, on September 15, 2011, the St. Charles Parish Council and Parish President signed the required letter of support for said project; and,
- WHEREAS, by way of a press conference held on November 22, 2011, in the St. Charles Parish Courthouse Council Chambers, HUD Regional Administrator C. Donald Babers announced the application was the only one in the state of Louisiana selected for a total of \$442,422 in federal funding; and,
- WHEREAS, HUD has prepared a Cooperative Agreement to obligate funding for said project and Amendment No. 1 to the Cooperative Agreement to correct the Recipient Amount and adjust the Effective Date and Period of Performance, as well as add other terms and conditions and it is the desire of the Parish Council to approve said Agreement.
