The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) acknowledges receipt of your letter and Phase II Environmental Site Assessment dated January 13, 2015. Please be advised that we are in the process of reviewing Phase II Environmental Site Assessment and we will contact you after the review is completed.

A preliminary review of our records indicate impacts from the former Underground Storage Tanks (USTs) are potentially eligible for the Louisiana Motor Fuels Underground Storage Tank Trust Fund. A final eligibility determination will be made after an application to the Louisiana Motor Fuels Underground Storage Tank Trust Fund has been reviewed. Please be advised that impacts from the hydraulic lifts will not be covered by the UST Trust Fund. However, the site, or portions thereof, may be addressed through other programs designed to help facilitate and promote the cleanup and redevelopment of potentially contaminated property.
