Proclamation: "Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month"

## **PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS,** *Alzheimer's disease is a progressive neurodegenerative brain disorder that tragically robs individuals of their memories and leads to progressive mental and physical impairments; and,*

**WHEREAS,** *Alzheimer's is currently ranked as the sixth leading cause of death in the United States, but recent estimates indicate that the disorder may rank third, just behind heart disease and cancer, as a cause of death for older people. Alzheimer's is the only cause of death in the top ten that currently cannot be prevented and has no cure; and,*

**WHEREAS,** *an estimate of 5.8 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's and by the year 2050, this number could rise to as high as 16 million; and,*

**WHEREAS,** *researchers around the world continue their efforts to develop scientific discoveries that could one day bring about a world without Alzheimer's disease; and,*

**WHEREAS,** *with early detection and diagnosis, individuals and their families can gain access to treatment medications which may help preserve daily functioning for some time, they can enroll in critical research trials, fully participate in planning for the future, and receive help and support from the Alzheimer's Association; and,*

**WHEREAS,** *there is a need to raise awareness about Alzheimer's disease and to honor all the caregivers who support and care for loved ones suffering with it.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** THAT WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL AND THE PARISH PRESIDENT, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE **MONTH OF JUNE 2019 AS**
